- a. Post 48 conducted our 2nd Annual American Legion Oratorical Scholarship Contest for high school youth with director, 4 judges, time keeper, score tabulators, contestant escorts.
Cost: \$110; Volunteer Hours: 40
- b. Post 48 held a recognition dinner for the local JROTC youths: Cost: \$170; Volunteer Hours: 30
- c. Awarded a college scholarship and JROTC (medals/certificates) for local high school youth:
Cost: \$560; Volunteer Hours: 10
- d. Conducted Interviews, solicited funding, made selections and sponsored 5 youths to attend 2014 Palmetto Boys State: Cost \$1500; Volunteer Hours: 100
- e. Conducted interviews, solicited funding, made selections and sponsored 2 youths to attend 2014 Palmetto Girls State: Cost \$600; Volunteer Hours: 40
- f. Conducted interviews, solicited funding, made a selection and sponsored 1 youth to attend Law Cadet Academy: Cost \$200; Volunteer Hours: 15
- g. Post 48 allowed the Chesnee High School JROTC Rifle Team to conduct indoor air-rifle practice and competition in our Post facility. Post 48 members volunteered time to assist with building preparation (take down and storage of tables/chairs) for each use. Practice was multiple times weekly with a considerable increase in Post utility//maintenance cost.
Cost: \$400; Volunteer Hours: 200
- h. Post 48 allowed the Chesnee High School Cheerleader Squad to utilize our facility for indoor practice. Utility Cost: \$100; Volunteer Hours: 10
- i. Supported the local Chesnee Police program (Kops Kids) providing toys to underprivileged children in the area: Cost: \$100; Volunteer Hours: 5
