CWP Class Preparation Information

1. If you are a veteran, bring your DD214 (required) and you may skip the shooting part of the course if you desire.
2. A handgun and 50 rounds of ammunition to fit the gun are required. It is recommended that you bring at least 60 rounds in case of a problem.
3. Hearing protection is mandatory. You may use ear-muffs or ear plugs. If you use hearing aids, you must be certain that they clip sounds above 80-90 db.
4. Eye protection is mandatory. If you wear eye glasses, they must be shatterproof. If you are not certain, buy an inexpensive set of “gun glasses” that are shatterproof.
5. A holster that your gun fits into properly is mandatory. While on the range, your gun must be holstered at any time you are not shooting.
6. You will shoot from 3, 5, 7, 10, & 15 yards into a silhouette target (provided). Your target will be scored. You must score 35 “hits” out of 50 shots within a required area. The target type will be either B-21 or B-27 silhouette.
7. There are two sections to the test after the classroom portion of the class. You must score at least 70% on the combined sections.
8. If you do not have a signed Post 48 Liability Agreement on record, you must sign a Liability Agreement in front of a witness on the day of the event. Forms will be available during the registration period.
9. **DO NOT BRING YOUR FIREARM INTO THE CLASSROOM.** Leave it locked in your automobile until instructed to retrieve it.
10. For Saturday classes, there will be a 30-minute break for lunch around noon. There are a number of fast-food restaurants less than a mile from the Post building.
