What is Veterans Transitional Housing?

The COL Joel M. Heiser VOQ, under contract by the Veteran's Administration, provides a 24-month program for homeless veterans. Any veteran who meets the definition of "homeless" qualifies for this program.

There is no cost to the veteran for this program as long as the veteran meets the requirements to remain at the facility.

All residents of the VOQ are required to work with a case manager, attend classes and/or sessions weekly, and remain alcohol and drug-free while residing at the facility.

All basic necessities will be provided for the Veteran including housing, meals, laundry services, transportation, case management, and recreation.

WHAT WE DO

The VOQ works in partnership with local community colleges, therapy groups, the local VA clinic and the VA hospital in Columbia to help Veterans connect with services available to them.

The VOQ will provide access to alcohol and drug rehabilitation programs, weekly AA and NA meetings, group therapy and individual counseling.

Training in life skills will be provided. These skills will include money management, healthy cooking, and relationship building.



GOALS

Our goal at the COL Joel M. Heiser VOQ is to provide homeless Veterans the skills necessary to integrate back into mainstream society. Among the many services offered to Veterans you will find:

- Job Skills Training
- Vocational Rehabilitation
 - Therapy
 - Counseling
- Money Management

When the Veteran completes the 24-month program he/she will have obtained the skills and education necessary to attain employment and sustainable housing.
