First, and foremost

**You Must
Know the Rules!**

Range Committee Training

When responding to an “Urgent Call”

- **Bring a note pad**
- **On the way in get auto license tag number(s)**
- **Ask for key – write down key number(s)**

Range Committee Training

When responding to an “Urgent Call”

- **Cite which rule they are violating**
- **Write down statements or remarks from them**

Range Committee Training

Sign-In Card

- **Ask to view Sign-In Card**
- **Check for correct information**
- **If they don't have one, write them up**
- **Tell them to leave the range**
- **They will hear from the Chairman**

Range Committee Training

Use Rules

- ✓ **Ask about Liability Agreement; Check on printed list**
- ✓ **No LA, write them up**
 - **In order to stay, they must fill one out and sign and you witness**
 - **Otherwise, they must leave immediately**

Range Committee Training

General Rules (written report required)

- **Key lending to unauthorized person**
- **Evidence of alcohol, drugs, or intoxicated people [they must leave the range]**
- **Someone digging lead from backstop**
- **Someone walking around on the backstop**

Range Committee Training

General Rules (written report required)

- **Someone lighting a fire**
- **Someone pointing their gun at the highway**
- **Someone putting plastic, glass, or metal into the burn barrel**

Range Committee Training

General Rules (written report required)

- **Someone dealing improperly with misfires**
- **Wrong shot size on Practice Turkey Shoot Range**
- **Improper trash/garbage in the gray container**

Range Committee Training

General Rule

**Minor violations use good judgement
(SAFETY FIRST)**

Range Committee Training

Safety Requirement Rules (written report required)

- **If multiple parties, who is RSO? No RSO write them up – all**
- **Mishandling a firearm**
- **If you detect cross-range shooting**
- **Any violations of youth rules**

Range Committee Training

Target Type Rules (written report required)

- **If shooting at glass, plastic, clay pigeons, exploding targets**
- **If they are shooting to close (<15 yards) to miscellaneous metal targets**
- **If they don't pick up their brass, warn them**

Range Committee Training

Firearms & Ammo Rules (written report required)

- **Automatic firearms are not permitted**
- **Incendiary or tracer ammunition is not permitted**
- **Armor piercing or steel core ammo is not permitted**
- **Cartridge velocity is tricky: any cartridge originally designed for a rifle is probably dangerous (5.7x28, 5.56x45 are examples)**

Range Committee Training

Firearms & Ammo Rules (written report required)

If shotgun:

- ❖ **Ask to look at the shotgun**
- ❖ **Get one or more empty shot shotshells to keep**
- ❖ **Cite the shot size maximum (#6 shot)**
- ❖ **Everything above the max shot size – write them up**
- ❖ **State shot shell contents in report**

Range Committee Training

Firearms & Ammo Rules (written report required)

If rifle:

- ❖ **Ask to look at the rifle**
- ❖ **Get one or more fired cartridges to keep**
- ❖ **Cite the rifle cartridge size maximum**
- ❖ **Everything above the max caliber – write them up**
- ❖ **State rifle cartridge size in report**

Range Committee Training

Gong Target Rules (written report required)

- **Inside the 25-yard barrier while they and/or someone else is shooting; they must leave**
- **Shooting at damaged or broken gongs**

Range Committee Training

The purpose of these rules is to protect the Post from liability cases and promote safety. If we, to the extent that we can, enforce our rules, we, hopefully, reduce our liability. If someone doesn't like our rules, invite them to find another range!
